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Dear Residence Hall Student:

Buffalo State is pleased to announce an affiliation agreement with Campus Walk, the new private student housing development adjacent to campus on Grant Street. The agreement designates Campus Walk as the preferred off-campus housing provider for senior-level Buffalo State students.

The 318-bed complex—which is on track to open in fall 2017—will feature apartments with private bathrooms for each resident, a common living room, and full-size washers and dryers in each unit. Other amenities will include a central study lounge, a computer lab with Apple products, and a state-of-the-art fitness center. Last year, the Housing Office initiated changes to the housing selection process, giving priority to freshmen and sophomore-level students who are required to live on campus. And now, with the new affiliation agreement in place with Campus Walk as the preferred off-campus housing provider for senior-level students, the college has agreed to limit campus housing to freshman, sophomore and junior level students only beginning fall 2017.

Beginning next academic year, senior standing students (90 credits or more) will no longer be able to request campus housing during the room selection process. As such, rising senior-level students are encouraged to seek their housing needs with Campus Walk for fall 2017. However, rising senior-level students can request to be placed on the Buffalo State housing “wait list,” but housing will only be provided based upon space availability, which will be determined in July 2017.

While Campus Walk is the preferred off-campus housing provider, rising seniors are permitted to seek off-campus accommodations with any other private housing development. Tips and resources to assist in your search for off-campus housing are available on our website.
